文学部は、質の高い教養教育と高度な専門教育を通して、人間・文化・社会への深い理解力や多様な言語能力を培い、今までの知の枠組みに囚われない柔軟な視点から自分で課

題を発見し解決に取り組む積極的な人材の育成を目指している。

古代から現代までの日本史・西洋史・東洋史をはじめ、世界各地の地理や環境問題、家族・医療・情報・文化等の社会学、さらには美術史や考古学も学べる「人文社会学科」、日本・中国・アメリカ・イギリス・ドイツ・フランスおよびそれらの文化が及ぶ諸地域における言語と文学を中心に、文化現象全般をも視野に収めて学ぶ「言語文化学科」、そして、社会と文化における人間と人間相互の生の営みに焦点を合わせ、「人間とは何か?」という問題について総合的に教育・研究する「人間科学科」の3学科から構成されている。

The Faculty of Letters at Nara Women's University provides an excellent education in liberal arts and specialized fields. It aims at cultivating those proactive individuals with a deep understanding of humanity, culture and society as well as various linguistic skills who can initiate tasks on their own and work out solutions from a flexible viewpoint free from the conventional framework of knowledge.

The Faculty consists of three departments: the Department of History, Sociology and Geography, the Department of Language and Culture, and the Department of Human Sciences. The Department of History, Sociology and Geography offers a range of courses on Japanese, Western and Eastern history from antiquity to contemporary times, geography and environmental issues in different parts of the world, sociologies of the family, medical, information, and culture, art history and archaeology. The Department of Language and Culture explores languages and literature as well as cultural phenomena in general in Japan, China, the U.S., Britain, Germany, France and those regions under their cultural influence. The Department of Human Sciences addresses the question of what humanity is through a comprehensive approach to human beings and their interactions in society and culture.
